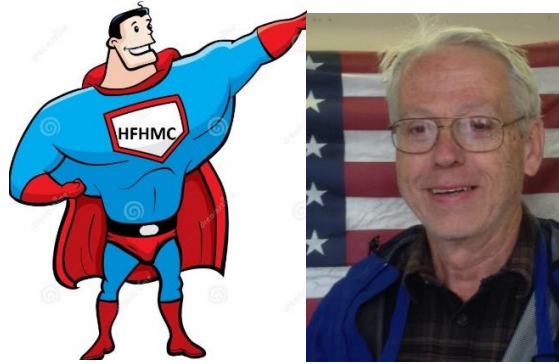


HABITAT HERO
